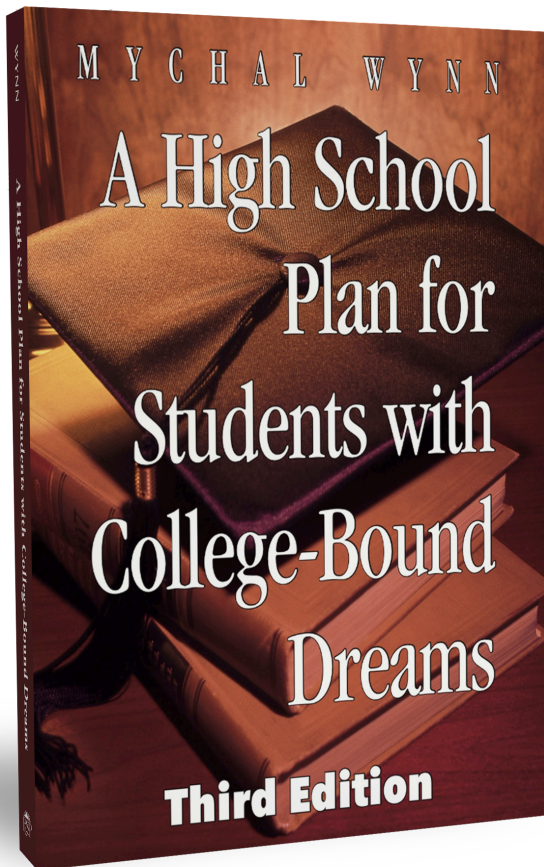


Find out why students love Mr. Wynn's authentic conversations about making career or college choices
