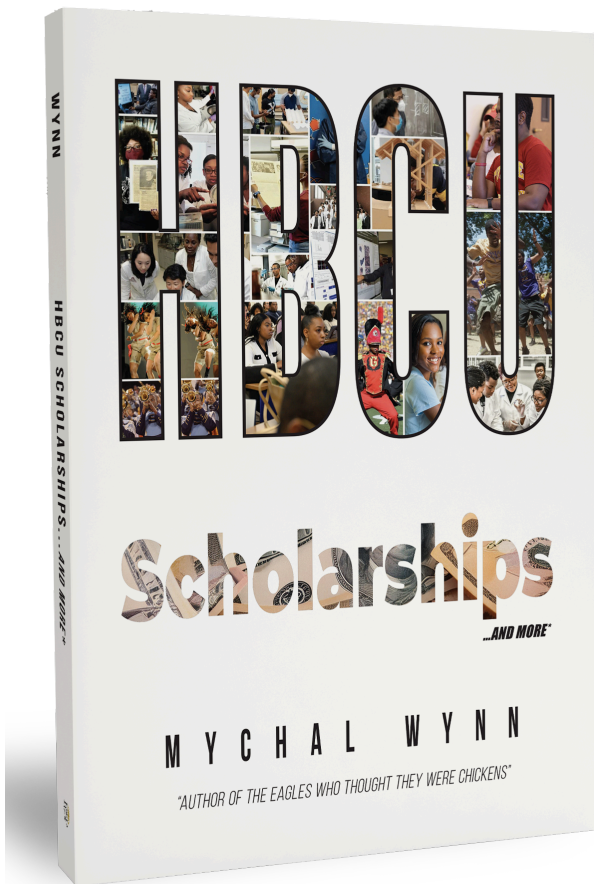


# Mychal Wynn FREE Black History Month HBCU Scholarship Session

- Getting into an HBCU where you have lower risk of losing your scholarship is a solution.
- Knowing how to write a high quality essay is a solution.
- Knowing when to apply, how to apply, and why quality applications are solutions.
- Having a good GPA and Class Rank is good, but having the 'right' GPA and the 'right' test scores is better.
